- Hope Hobbs Gazebo: The Gazebo, located at Wells Harbor Community Park, is ideal for wedding ceremonies, bands and small performances and is available to be rented and reserved for your function or event. It has ample bench seating and adjacent parking. Restroom facilities are approximately 450 feet away.
- Harbor Pavilion: The Harbor Pavilion, located at Wells Harbor Community Park, is ideal for receptions, reunions, or other seated events. Seating for approximately 100 people.
- Wells Activity Center: 113 Sanford Road, Wells, ME The Wells Activity Center is a 4,160 SF building on 3 acres of town owned land with ample off-street parking on Route 109. The Activity Center is used for a variety of Parks and Recreation Department programs and events. The facility is also available for other functions and events on weekends upon reservation.

• Wells Residents: \$60.00 per hour

• Non-Residents: \$70.00 per hour

be returned to the Designated User within 30 business days after the function if all conditions of
the Use Agreement have been met.

Is there electricity at the facilities?

• Yes, all our facilities have electricity.

Are there restrooms available at the facilities?

• Yes, there are restrooms at all our facilities.

I understand that there is a kitchen at the Wells Activity Center. Is cooking permitted there?

- Cooking may be done at the Activity Center, but additional proof of insurance is required (typically held by a caterer) (\$50,000 min.)
- Crock pots and cold food may be brought in to be served.

Are there BBQ grills at the pavilion or the gazebo?

 No, we do not have BBQ grills at our facilities, but you are welcome to bring your own. Please refer to cooking requirements.

Do you have tables and chairs available at the Wells Activity Center?

- Tables and chairs are available upon request.
- Tablecloths are available at a small fee.

May we serve alcohol at our event?

- The serving and sale of alcoholic beverages is permitted, but only can be provided and served by a State of Maine licensed caterer or bartender who carries off-site liquor liability insurance.
- Any functions which are BYOB (Bring Your Own Bottle), must have a "Rentee Function Permit", issued by the State of Maine. Permit applications can be obtained by calling the State of Maine Liquor Enforcement at 624-8750. A copy of this permit must be submitted to the Town, together with the Use Agreement and the Use Application Form.
- The Wells Police Department shall be notified of the time and place of any function where alcohol is permitted. A police officer may be required at the expense of the Designated User as determined by the Chief of Police.
